Fantastique!!! Vous lisez mon site d'internet!!! I am hoping to offer up some vary valuable help for your exam. Let me also offer that quizlet.com and our online textbook provide some other help, as well.

First, the format of the exam:

Listening: 1.) Know the expressions that we have learned for asking for help, asking for advice, wishing someone a good time, or asking if something has been done. 2.) Be able to identify stated vocabulary words in a drawing.

Reading: 1.) Read two small articles that have to do with holidays and gift giving, and answer some T/F questions. 2.) Read an e-mail about what happened at a party. –Know your vocab!!!!

Culture: Answer multiple choice questions that have to do with: What one would not give to a hostess when having dinner at a friend's house. Read p. 53. When is the holiday in which something is hidden in a cake? (p. 44) What doesn't occur when the French "faire le pont" (p. 60). When are the Réveillon Feasts? Of course, all of this will be in French, so read over the information in your text to be fully prepared.

Vocabulary: 1.) Label pictures of vocabulary words and tell what holiday would be associated with each item. 2.) Read a list of words and tell what holiday would be associated with those things. 3.) Read a paragraph and fill in blanks with appropriate vocabulary words that are provided. STUDY YOUR VOCAB LISTS!!! Flash cards and quizlet.com might help!

Grammar: 1.) Fill in the blanks with the passé composé of a verb that is given. 2.) Read a statement and response, and fill in a blank with the correct object pronoun.

Writing: Write a note to a friend who couldn't attend your birthday party. Thank him/her for the gift, and tell about the party. Note: You are writing about an event that already happened. This means that you will use the passé compose!!!

THAT IS EXACTLY WHAT IS ON THE TEST!! NOW, GO STUDY!!

Also, here is a list of activities from your online textbook that you could do to help you prepare.

p. 44 Ex 2, p. 49 Ex 12, p. 56 Ex 22, p. 71 Ex 4 (You won't be able to do #5, though)
