Grade Information:

Srades may be accessed by parents via Parent Portal. Grades will be updated weekly.

Homework:

Homework might consist of practice worksheets or lessons and notes to be completed at home.

- Any practice worksheets assigned as homework not completed BEFORE you walk into the classroom is considered LATE! Late work is penalized. This work can be completed, however fifty percent (50%) of the total points earned will be deducted on late work. Late work will NOT be accepted after the day it is due!!!
- From time to time students will be expected to watch lessons and take notes outside of class. With each video lesson students will either take a notes quiz the next day in class, or complete an electronic assignment (or sometimes both). If the students do not do their video assignment, there will NOT be an opportunity to make up missed points on the quizzes or electronic assignments. It is extremely important for students to watch assigned lessons ON TIME!

Absence Policy:

If you are absent, it is your responsibility to make up any missed work. This might be reading from the book, copying notes or finishing assignments. You will have one day, for each missed day, to make up work. You can see what we did each day by visiting the calendar on mrsburton.com.

Quizzes and tests will be made-up the day you return. (YOU MUST COME TO ME.) You have one week to do this.

Class Participation Policy:

Due to the nature of this class, there will be a lot of opportunities for students to participate in class. THIS IS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE CLASS; YOU WILL HAVE TO SPEAK FRENCH!!!!! You will be required to speak French with me, with the class, with a group, and with a partner. The best way to learn French is to use French. Expect to speak French everyday!

Policy for Leaving During Class: (The building guidelines will be followed)
