To create:

- -Insert Images
- -Insert Audio (record onto the presentation or insert audio created using "Sound Recorder"

To Submit

-Upload your PowerPoint file on Schoology

To create:

- 1. Click "Begin New Story"
- 2. Import Images (Make sure that images are with you until you render the video), Click Next
- 3. Add text (if necessary), Click Next
- 4. Click the record button, and record audio, Click Next



- 5. You can add music, IF it is not a distraction
- 6. Click on "Save Your Story for Play Back on Your Computer" (This step is very important!!)
 - --Make sure to note the location that your file is being saved to
 - -Click on Browse to save your file to your flashdrive or desktop
- 7. A window should come up saying "Building Your Story", and you will be able to view your project

To submit

1. Submit your file (It must be a .wmv file!!) on to Schoology

IMovie

To create:

- -Use your Iphone or IPad.
- -Go to Projects, and create a new project, create movie
- -Insert images or take pictures of the photos for your project (choose these from your camera roll)
- -Record Audio (use an app on your device) and insert into movie
- -Publish video (publish to Imovie, then email the file to yourself)

To Submit

- -Email the file to yourself and save the file to your computer or flashdrive
- -Submit the file onto Schoology or Upload to YouTube and submit the link

Yodio

To create:

- 1. Create a Yodio Account by going to Yodio.com
 - -Use Chrome
 - -Problems may occur if you don't click on the top right of your browser window in order to
 - "Load Unsafe Content" (Don't worry, it's safe, it is a coding issue)
- 2. Click on "Create Yodio"
- 3. Insert Images
- 4. Insert Audio
 - -This must be audio that you have previously created and saved into an .mp3 file or .wav file
 - -You may convert files that you created using a recording app on your phone using zamzar.com
- 5. Align Audio Files and Image files on the Video Pane on the right side
- 6. Publish Yodio

To submit:

- 1. Go to "Share/Embed" and copy the "Quick link" after you have published your Yodio
- 2. On Schoology.com, click on "Submit Assignment" under the assignment.
- 3. Choose "Create"
- 4. Click on the "Link Option", and copy the "Quick Link" of your yodio project
- 5. Click "Save"
