

## Examen de Chapitre 3

As I said in class, the biggest component of the Chapter 3 exam is vocabulary. We have had a lot in this chapter, so study up!! You might think about using Quizlet.com. If you search for Bien Dit Level 2, Chapter 3 will come up, and voilà Flashcards!! There is so much vocabulary in this chapter. You will need to know the stores and the foods that would be bought there, as well as the measurements (une livre, un kilo, une tasse, etc). We also have locations in this chapter. We couldn't possibly have gone over all of the vocabulary in class enough for you to have it all memorized. You really must study all words and expressions on the vocab lists. You will use these words on the listening sections, the reading sections and the writing section (read the hints below!!).

You might want to spend some time looking over the information on partitive articles. And as I said in class, try doing Exercises 7 and 8 on pages 86 and 87 of your on-line textbook.

There will be a few sections that involve the object pronouns y and en. It will be a great idea to at least read over the notes that we took over these pronouns.

Just in case we don't get to the question section of the review in class: there aren't any questions where you have to write specific questions, but the writing section of the test does ask you to write an email, in which you would need to ask some of the following questions. Know your question words!!

Here is what you could've said:

1. Where do you live? (habiter = to live) : Où est-ce que tu habites? or Où habites-tu ?
2. What do you like to eat?: Qu'est-ce que tu aimes manger?
3. When should I arrive? Quand est-ce que je viens chez toi? or Quand viens-je chez toi ?
4. What can I bring? Qu'est-ce que je peux rapporter ? or Que peux-je rapporter ?
