

Préparez-vous!!!

As I have said, the chapter 3 test is a tough one. It requires some preparation. To help you to feel more confident and better prepared, here are some tips:

ÉCOUTONS

Know your adjectives (especially the pronunciation difference between masculine and feminine words) and family member vocab. As usual, these sections can be tricky. YOU MUST know your family member vocab.

LISONS

You will be reading a paragraph and a conversation and answering questions. Again, adjectives and family member vocab is a must for these sections.

CULTURE

This is the easiest section IF you prepare. The section is a matching section. Read through pages 82,86,88,92,96. (MAKE SURE THAT YOU READ P. 88, WE DIDN'T GET TO DO THAT IN CLASS!)

VOCABULAIRE

You will be explaining family member relationships (le fils du fils de mere c'est _____). We have done this a lot in class, but, again, you must be able to understand family member vocab!!! Also, you will be writing sentences to describe people (teachers at your school, your favorite actress, an athlete, American teens, etc). For each person given, you will need to write two sentences. Practice how to say is and are, as well as adjective agreement.

GRAMMAIRE

For grammar you will be completing sentences with the possessive adjectives. Make sure you know all of the ways of saying my, your, his, her, our, your all's and their. Also, in this section you will be completing sentences with the forms of "être", and the way of saying "of the".

ÉCRIVONS

The last section will be a writing section. You will have a family photo to look at. The directions will tell you to write a paragraph about Gérald's family. A BIG TIP: Remember that if you are saying "Gerald's grandma"... there is NO APOSTROPHE S in French. The way to say that in French is "la grand-mère de Gérald". Also, to say "his grandma" is "sa grand-mère"
